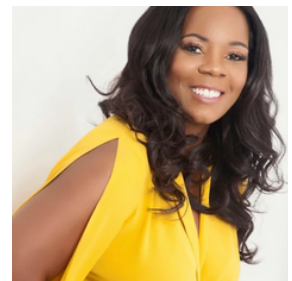

A combination of keynote, panel, breakout sessions, happy hour and workshops are planned for the two days. In-person and virtual attendees will gather together to assess their data leadership skills, perform an individual SWOT data analysis and develop their action plan. September 30th is dedicated to ways to support their data leadership growth and October 1st focuses on messaging their expertise and management styles to activate their growth. Online attendees will participate, engage and network via an immersive virtual event platform while in-person attendees will interact at GSU's College of Law.

The Black Women in Data Summit 2023 is ideal for Black women with 5+ years of work experience and who have earned an advanced degree (preferably in a data-related discipline). Her data skills are transferable across the academic, corporate government and non-profit arenas. The Summit is a time for attendees to recalibrate, recharge and reinvest in their professional development.

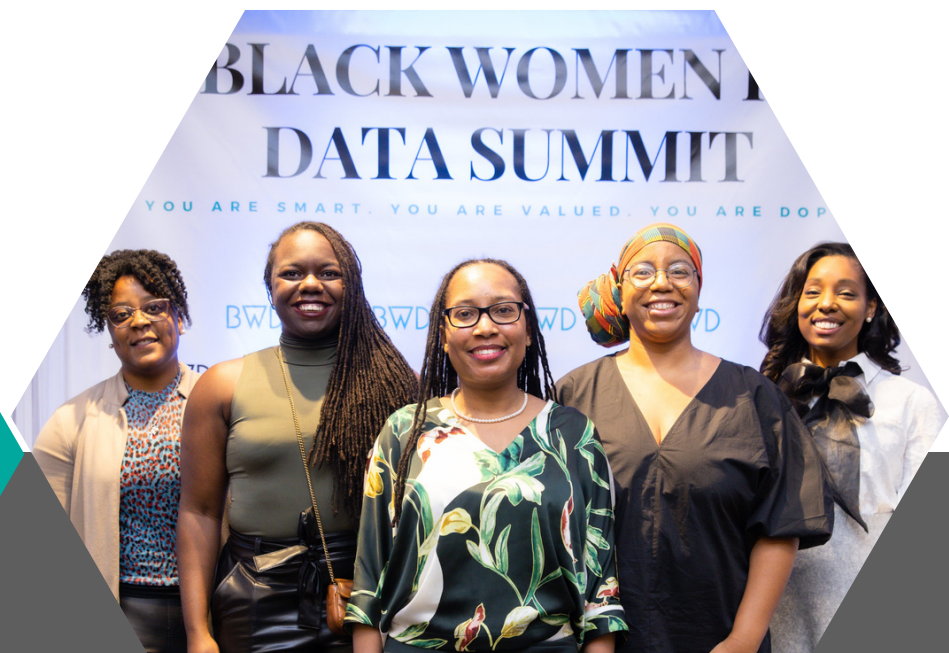
